DUTIES:

Reporting to the Director, Athletics and Recreation, the Head Coach, Women's Basketball is responsible for the overall direction, performance, and operation of the women's basketball program within university, Canada West, and U SPORTS policies and procedures. Responsibilities include but are not limited to: student-athlete recruitment, program planning, athlete management, student-athlete development, financial management / budgeting, sport development, fundraising (for program enhancements), administrative duties associated with the program, and day-to-day team operations. Qualified candidates must have a proven track record of coaching success, and a leadership style characterized by enthusiasm, integrity, and discipline. Candidates must have demonstrated ability to nurture and develop relationships with athletes, staff, faculty, students, media, alumni, donors, and the community at large.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates must have an undergraduate degree. Candidates should have a minimum coaching certification of NCCP Level 3 (or equivalent). Candidates should have a proven ability to recruit and must have a plan to recruit high performance student-athletes in accordance with U SPORTS regulations. Candidates to lead this program should have a minimum of five years' experience coaching high performance athletes, and a track record of developing a program that focusses on success in the classroom, in the community, and on the court. Applicants must address their abilities to coach students to athletic and academic excellence.

In addition to the above, it is expected that the successful candidate will:

- Stay current with knowledge, trends and practices that are necessary to build and maintain a nationally competitive program
- Attend league meetings to represent the interests of TRU and ensure compliance with all Canada West and U SPORTS regulations
- Maintain positive relationships with other sport governing bodies at the local, regional, provincial, and national levels
- Maintain a high profile in the sport locally, provincially and nationally acting as an ambassador representing the team and university
