

BASKETBALL BC PLAYER SELECTION PROCESS POLICY

1. ZONE AND PROVINCIAL TEAM PLAYER SELECTION PROCESS

1.1 Basketball BC High Performance (HP) Committee has developed the following Player Selection procedure that must be followed for the selection of players to provincial or zone teams. This process offers an equitable and fair opportunity to all participants attempting to become a member of a Basketball BC team.

2. SELECTION PROCEDURE

2.1 The Selection Committee Chairperson or Zone Team Head Coach will direct each meeting.

2.2 Meetings should occur regularly during the camp training component.

2.3 There must be list of the players at each meeting.

2.4 A brief record of comments made regarding each player should be kept cumulatively.

2.5 Each player is graded on their performance after each session of the camp, and is given one of three designations:

- a. a (+) indicating positive performance
- b. an (O) indicating neutral performance
- c. a (-) indicating performance poor performance

2.6 On each subsequent meeting players may be moved from one category to another but should only be moved one position at a time i.e.

- a. A player can move from (-) to (O), from (O) to (+), from (+) to (O), and from (O) to (-);
- b. A player should not move two groups i.e. from (-) to (+) or from (+) to (-).

2.7 If needed an additional method of assessing players is to compare them by position and rank them in descending order based on their comparative performance.

3. PROVINCIAL TRYOUTS

3.1 U15 Provincial Team Selection Process may have up to 3 parts to the final selection

- i. Zone Identification Camps – Players are identified to move onto Provincial Super Camp
- ii. Super Camp – Players are assessed to be moved onto the Selection Camp
- iii. Selection Camp – Players are selected onto the provincial team based on their performance in both the Super Camp and Selection Camp(s)

- 3.2 U17 Provincial Team Selection Process is a 2-part procedure
- i. Super Camp – Players are assessed to be moved onto the Selection Camp
 - ii. Selection Camp – Players are selected onto the provincial team based on their performance in both the Super Camp and Selection Camp(s)

4. ZONE/TRAVEL TEAM TRYOUTS

- 4.1 Team Selection Process is a 1part procedure
- a. Team tryout can occur on 1 day or split over 2 or more days.

5. PROVINCIAL TEAM SELECTION PROCESS

- 5.1 Each coach at the Supercamp is a member of the Selection Committee to help determine athletes to be moved onto Selection Camp.
- 5.2 The Selection Camp Committee will meet on the final day to finalize the team roster. This Committee will take input from all coaches and is comprised of Selection Committee Chair, Basketball BC Manager of High Performance and Provincial Team Head Coach.
- 5.3 The exceptions to include the following:
- a. Apprentice coaches may have oral input in the selection process but may not vote for players;
 - b. Coaches shall refrain from providing evaluations or commentary on relatives participating in the camp and are required to disclose any actual or perceived conflicts of interest regarding players under their current supervision in school or club programs.

6. POST CAMP PROCEDURE

- 6.1 All participants in the Selection Camp must be informed of the results of the camp within 48 hours of the completion of Camp.
- 6.2 Coaches are encouraged to give personal feedback to each of the players at the Selection camp. This can be done via face-to-face or through email
