> 1. Boys and Girls of all levels (Jrs., A, AA, AAA, and AAAA) shall play the same rules in all games (Including exhibition, tournament, league, playoff, and Provincial Championship games)

2. THE SHOT CLOCK WILL BE RESET TO 30 SECONDS ON A NEW POSSESSION OF A LIVE BALL, AND 18 SECONDS AFTER A TURNOVER IN TEAM A'S BACK COURT / TEAM B'S FRONT COURT.

THE SHOT CLOCK WILL RESET TO 18 SECONDS WHEN A TEAM STARTS A NEW POSSESSION IN THEIR FRONTCOURT AFTER A STOPPAGE IN PLAY AND A NEW POSSESSION.

TO HELP WITH LIMITATIONS OF ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, THE SHOT CLOCK WILL BE SET TO 18 SECONDS DURING A LAST OR ONLY FREE THROW. IF THE OFFENSIVE TEAM CONTROLS THE REBOUND COMING OFF A LAST OR ONLY FREE THROW, IT WILL RUN DOWN FROM THAT 18. IF THE OFFENSIVE OR DEFENSIVE TEAM CONTROLS THE REBOUND WHILE THE CLOCK IS RUNNING, IT WILL BE FULLY RESET AND RUN DOWN FROM 30

3. ALL GAMES WILL HAVE A 10-SECOND BACKCOURT COUNT

4. TIME-OUTS: EACH TEAM WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR:

- - 2 TIME-OUTS IN THE FIRST HALF

- - 3 TIME-OUTS DURING ANY TIME IN THE SECOND HALF, IF A COACH HAS 3 TIMEOUTS UNDER 2 MINUTES IN THE 4TH QUARTER, THEY WILL <u>NOT LOSE THEIR THIRD TIMEOUT.</u>

- - 1 TIME-OUT DURING EACH OVERTIME

NOTE: THE FIBA RULE CLEARLY STATES THAT UNUSED TIME-OUTS <u>MAY</u> <u>NOT</u> BE CARRIED OVER TO THE NEXT HALF OR OVERTIME BC High School Basketball Modification of FIBA Rules & Changes – 2022-23

5. ALL GAMES WILL BE PLAYED ON COURTS WITH MODIFIED LINES PAINTED ON THAT COURT'S FLOOR (IE: THE "NARROW" NCAA RESTRICTED AREA, AND THE "CLOSER" 6.25 METRE 3-POINT LINE WILL BE USED)

IF THE ABOVE MODIFIED LINES ARE NOT PAINTED ON THE COURT, FIBA-DIMENSIONED LINES WILL BE USED INSTEAD (INCLUDING THE "WIDE" FIBA KEY OR THE "TRAPEZOID" KEY, & THE 6.75 METRE 3 POINT LINE)

In addition, the no-charge semi-circle rule <u>shall NOT</u> <u>apply</u> this season

IF A NCAA RESTRICTED AREA IS NOT AVAILABLE (AS PER** LAST SLIDE), TEAMS MUST USE THE BIGGER, FIBA **KEY, AND THE FIRST DEFENSIVE LANE SPACE SHALL BELOW THE NEUTRAL SPACE BLOCK** BE

8. T-SHIRTS (SHORT OR LONG SLEEVE) HEADGEAR, WRISTBANDS, AND COMPRESSION CLOTHING SHALL BE PERMITTED IN HIGH SCHOOL GAMES

WHATEVER COLOUR IS CHOSEN, ALL PLAYERS ON THAT TEAM MUST ADHERE TO AND WEAR THE SAME COLOUR OF T-SHIRTS AND/OR COMPRESSION CLOTHING AS THE REST OF THEIR TEAMMATES

9. RELIGIOUS OR MEDICAL BRACELETS / NECKLACES ARE PERMITTED, BUT MUST BE ADEQUATELY AND SAFELY COVERED BY PROTECTIVE COVERING(S), AT MINIMUM TAPE AND/OR A SWEATBAND

10. PLAYING TIME SPECIFICATIONS:

a) Junior Boys & Girls (and below):

I. 4 X 8-MINUTE QUARTERS

II. 4-MINUTE OVERTIME PERIOD(S)

III. 1 MINUTE BETWEEN QUARTERS

IV. 8-MINUTE HALF TIME (OR LESS IF BOTH COACHES AGREE)

V. 8-MINUTE WARM UP (OR LONGER / SHORTER IF TIME PERMITS AND AGREED TO BY BOTH COACHES, TOURNAMENT ORGANIZERS, ETC.)

11. NOISEMAKERS: ARTIFICIAL SOUND; LASER POINTERS – EG: AEROSOL AIR HORNS, LOUD SPEAKERS, MEGAPHONES, WHISTLES, AND/OR LASER POINTERS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME FROM ANYONE IN THE GYM (COACHES, SPECTATORS, ETC.)

NOTE: SHOULD A SITUATION ARISE REGARDING NOISEMAKERS, THE GAME SHALL BE STOPPED (AT AN APPROPRIATE TIME DURING A NATURAL STOPPAGE OF PLAY), IT SHALL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE GAME DIRECTOR, TOURNAMENT ORGANIZER, OR HOME TEAM HEAD COACH TO IMMEDIATELY ADDRESS THE ISSUE AT HAND

A) IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SCHOOL / COACH / AD / ADMINISTRATOR TO BE PREPARED, BEFORE THE START OF THE GAME, FOR THE POSSIBILITY OF, AND PLAN FOR, ANY PLAYER OR COACH DISQUALIFICATION

B) WHEN THERE IS NO ASSISTANT COACH NAMED ON THE SCORE SHEET AND THE HEAD COACH IS DISQUALIFIED, OR SHOULD BOTH THE HEAD COACH AND THE ASSISTANT COACH BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE GAME, THE GAME SHALL BE FORFEITED TO THEIR OPPONENTS, REGARDLESS OF THE SCORE (SCORE AT TIME OF DISQUALIFICATION IF DISQUALIFIED COACH'S TEAM IS LOSING, OR 2-0 IF THEY ARE WINNING)

Ejections

C) PLAYERS WHO ARE DISQUALIFIED <u>SHALL NOT</u> BE PERMITTED TO REMAIN ON THE TEAM BENCHES OR BE IN THE GYMNASIUM.

PLAYERS OR COACHES WHO ARE DISQUALIFIED MUST GO TO THE CHANGING ROOM, AND LEAVE THE GYMNASIUM

A DISQUALIFIED PLAYER IS REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE FIELD OF PLAY, MEANING THE COMPETITION GYMNASIUM. IF NO SUITABLE SUPERVISION IS AVAILABLE FOR THE STUDENT-ATHLETE, THE PLAYER MAY REMAIN ON THE BENCH BUT MAY NOT COMMUNICATE WITH OTHER MEMBERS OF THE TEAM OR THE OFFICIALS.

-13. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL ANY VIDEO OR RECORDING SYSTEM BE USED TO ASSIST AN OFFICIAL IN A DECISION OR CALL MADE / NOT MADE
