<u>ADDITIONAL DETAILS</u>	
ELIGIBILITY	All players MUST be born in 2004 or later (verified by birth certificate) or in first year of Grade 7.

Teams must have validation documents (birth certificate or principal declaration of grade) at each game for viewing if asked. If challenged, failure to be able to prove a participant's eligibility will make that athlete ineligible. All games that the athlete has played in will be forfeit (20-0); the team will be able

to play all remaining round robin games but will NOT be seeded into the playoffs.

Players may ONLY play for one team per tournament

ALIGNMENT

It is *anticipated* that there will be three divisions for each boys and girls tournaments, structured to allow for as equitable competition as possible. A is considered to be a higher competitive level than B and B higher than C. However please note the final amount of divisions will be dictated by various factors including total # of teams entered

Basketball BC reserves the right to place teams in a particular division (see guidelines)

GUIDELINES

Basketball BC will be the final determinant of number of divisions per gender, what division a team is in and their seeding.

Basketball BC will use the following criteria (in no particular priority) along with any other pertinent information to determine divisions and seeding:

- Quantity of player pool team drawn from
- U13 Metro League participation and results (if applicable)
- Tournament and game results
- Team history (previous provincial tournament results)
- Team average age/grade
- Time team has been together
- Team preference

ROSTER NOTES

Teams must have a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 15 on their roster. A minimum of 8 **MUST BE AVAILABLE** for every game or team may be subject to forfeiture unless opposing team agrees to allow team to play with a lesser amount.
